Alpine Health Technologies, Corp. is a company founded in 2004, in compliance with all laws applicable to our Industry, characterized by honest, integral, and fair practices.

We value the relationship with our customers, users, followers, and visitors. Therefore, this document discloses the privacy practices of Alpine (“Privacy Policy”). As part of our normal operation, we collect and, in some cases, disclose information about you to third parties. This Privacy Policy describes the information we collect about you, how we may use it, and what may happen to that information. By continuing, you expressly consent to our use and disclosure of your personally identifiable information in accordance with this Privacy Policy and applicable law.

We will always respect your wishes if you tell us that you do not wish to provide us with access to your information. You can unsubscribe any time from our email list using the link located at the footer.

Alpine don't sell your personal information, but we still have to tell you what we collect from you when you access or use our websites and how we use them. We may update this policy from time to time. In case that we change our privacy policy, we will send you a notification to your email address with the date and the details of the amendment. Your continued use of this site indicates your agreement to updated terms.

If you are a minor, you can use this service only in conjunction with the consent and under the supervision of your parents or legal guardians. If you are under 13 years of age, please do not access, or use our website. We do not knowingly collect or maintain personal information from people under 13. If we find out the personal information of people under 13 is collected on or through our website, we will delete it.

1. What personal information do we collect?

Depending on how you interact with our website, we may collect the following personal information about you, which we have grouped as follows:

- **Identity Data:** It may include your first name, last name, and title.
- **Contact Data:** It may include your postal address, email address, and telephone numbers.
- **Profile Data:** It may include username, password, purchases made by you, and customer service requests.
- **Technical Data:** It includes your internet protocol (IP) address, browser type, and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, and operating system and platform.
- **Usage Data:** It includes information about how you use our website.
- **Marketing and Communications Data:** It includes your preferences in receiving marketing and non-marketing communications from us.



- **Employment Data:** If applying for employment with Alpine Health Technologies, we collect employment, work history, and personal information concerning your potential hiring. These may include your education and employment history, address and contact information, demographic information, and any other information from your resume or application.

2. How do we collect personal information?

We may collect personal information about you from the following sources:

- **User-submitted information.** Such as subscription to our publications, purchasing an item, requesting marketing to be sent to you, entering a promotion, completing a survey, or corresponding with us in any way available.
- **Information collected automatically.** As you interact with our website, we will automatically collect Technical Data about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns. We collect this personal data using cookies, server logs, and other similar technologies.
- **Publicly available sources.** such as information that you or your organization make publicly available online.

3. How we use personal information?

4. With whom do we share personal information?

We may share your personal information with the following categories of third parties:

• **Our Customers, Service Providers and Partners.** We may transfer your personal information to our customers, service providers, and partners. Our customers, service providers and business partners might need your information for us and them to provide services in connection with our business fulfilment. For example, we may rely on Service providers to process payments, collect debts, transmit communications, deliver products and prizes, and perform analytics services, among other services. Our service providers are located and process personal information in the following countries: United States and Puerto Rico.

If you want, you can complete an exclusion application to order us to not share your personal information with our business partners, customers, and service providers. • **Government Agencies, Regulators and Professional Advisors.** Where permitted or required by applicable law, we may also need to transfer your personal data to government agencies and regulators (e.g., tax authorities, courts, and government authorities) to comply with our legal obligations, and to external professional advisors as necessary to defend our legal interests.

• **Legal Enforcement.** We may disclose any information about you to law enforcement or other government officials as we, in our sole discretion, believe necessary or appropriate, in connection with an investigation of fraud, intellectual property infringements, or other activity that is illegal or may expose us to legal liability.

• **Organizations Involved in Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, reorganization, dissolution or similar corporate event, or the sale of all or substantially all of our assets, we expect that the information that we have collected, including personal information, will be transferred to the surviving entity in a merger or the acquiring entity. Such information will be transferred in accordance with applicable law.



5. How do we protect personal information?

We maintain physical, administrative, and technological safeguards intended to prevent personal information from accidental or unauthorized loss, alteration access or use. We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected breach of personal information and will notify individuals and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

We limit access to your information only to those employees who need it to provide services and products to you or those who need access to it. We comply with federal and state privacy regulations in healthcare and other industries. Our employees are responsible for complying with our Privacy Policy and its principles.

We also maintain the physical and electronic security measures necessary to safeguard the confidentiality of your information, as required by law and this policy. Our site doesn't follow the DNT setting.

6. Your Privacy Rights

You have the right, under applicable laws, to request access, update, rectify, port, or erase your personal information. You can also restrict or object to activities in which we engage with your data. If your request complies with applicable laws, your right will take effect.
